FREE GERIATRIC SCREENING

Saint Louis University's Geriatric Education Center (GEC) is offering a free Geriatric Screening for anyone age 65 years or older on Saturday, June 10, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. till Noon. The screening will take place at the Learning Resources Center of the Saint Louis University Medical School campus.

The Screening will include assessment of:

- ✓ Frailty**
- ✓ Nutrition**
- ✓ Cognitive Function**

The assessments only take 10-15 minutes and participants who screen positive are given a list of specific interventions they can start right away as well as their results to share with their primary care provider. If they do not have a primary care provider we offer a list of local resources.

To make an appointment please call 314-977-8848 and leave a message with your preferred time, name, mailing address and age and we will confirm by return call. There will be multiple screeners available so appointments will be made in 15 minute increments. Confirmations will also be mailed to you along with driving and free parking instructions.
